The Game Schedule

First Session: 4pm – 6pm The first session is Family Friendly, no alcohol available.

Second Session: 7pm – 9pm

Third Session: 9pm – 11pm

Helpful info:

- Each session includes 30 minutes of instruction, followed by 90 minutes of play.
 - There are four playing fields ('sheets') on the ice, which means four concurrent games at once. There are four players on each team. We can fit 32 playing members on the whole ice per session (four games with eight players times four sheets).
 - If you are coming with intention to curl, wear clean flat sole shoes and comfy clothing.
