

## 12.1 Bargaining Committee

- (a) The Bargaining Committee for Unit 1 shall consist of five members elected at a General Membership Meeting, as well as the President of the Local. The CUPE Representative assigned to the Local shall be a non-voting member of the Committee and shall be consulted at all stages from formulating proposals, through negotiations, to contract ratification by the membership. Only members in good standing of Unit 1 shall be eligible to run for these positions
- (b) The Bargaining Committee for Unit 2 shall consist of ~~three~~ **two** members elected at a General Membership Meeting, as well as the President of the Local. The CUPE Representative assigned to the Local shall be a non-voting member of the Committee and shall be consulted at all stages from formulating proposals, through negotiations, to contract ratification by the membership. In the event of a vacancy, the Vice-President Unit 2 shall be appointed to the committee. Only members in good standing of Unit 2 shall be eligible to run for these positions.
- (c) The Bargaining Committee for Unit 3 shall consist of ~~four~~ **three** members elected a General Membership Meeting, as well as the President of the Local. The CUPE Representative assigned to the Local shall be a non-voting member of the Committee and shall be consulted at all stages from formulating proposals, through negotiations, to contract ratification by the membership. In the event of a vacancy, the Vice-President Unit 3 shall be appointed to the committee. Only members in good standing of Unit 3 shall be eligible to run for these positions.
