

Location: The Film House Comments: Audit conducted Jan. 21, 2024. Is there space a barrier free path to the small Accessible by elevator from the main lobby. A lecture hall? secondary entrance to the Film House theater is from the raceway between the FOPAC and Marilyn I. Walker campus. The centre row is wide, allowing for up to six wheelchairs in the audience. Could a person with mobility issues deliver a Yes. The lecture stage is accessible via a wide lecture without issue(s)? access way from the ground level entrance. Is there an Air Purifier? No. There is no portable air purifier present. If 'yes', is it running? However, the air wasn't stuffy, suggesting that an air circulation system is in place.
